The Sunapee Heritage Alliance-(SHA), has received a timely and much appreciated grant from 1772 Foundation in cooperation with the New Hampshire Preservation Alliance.

SHA recently received a \$5,750 matching grant to accomplish historic preservation projects. The grant will help further SHA's mission of restoring The Livery by painting the exterior. This much needed facelift will help preserve The Livery for many years to come. The Livery in Sunapee Harbor is the last structure left from the bygone days of steamships and Grand Hotels on Lake Sunapee. The Livery was designated as a "7 to Save" property in October of 2008, and this grant from the 1772 Foundation in cooperation with the New Hampshire Preservation Alliance will visibly highlight the restoration progress made to date to the ever-growing number of visitors and local event attendees that have become part of The Livery experience and its continued history.
